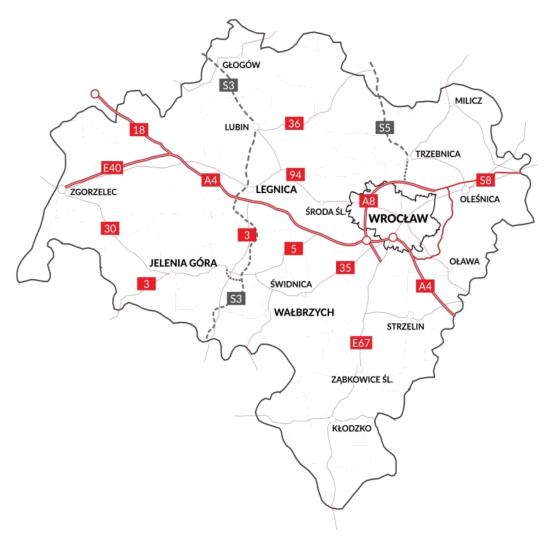

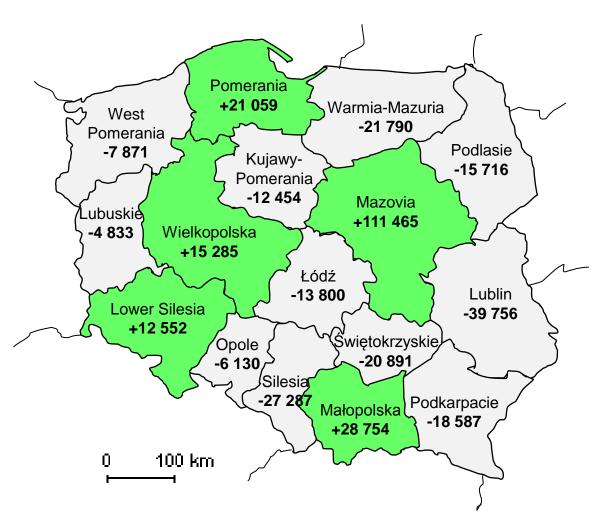

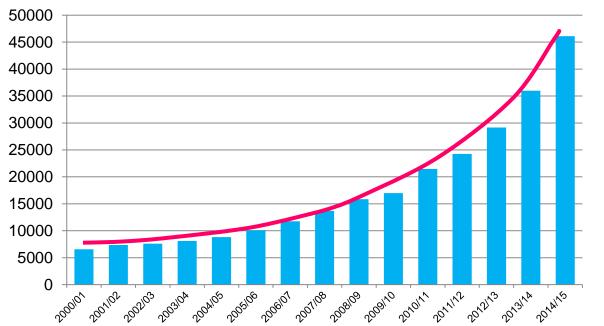

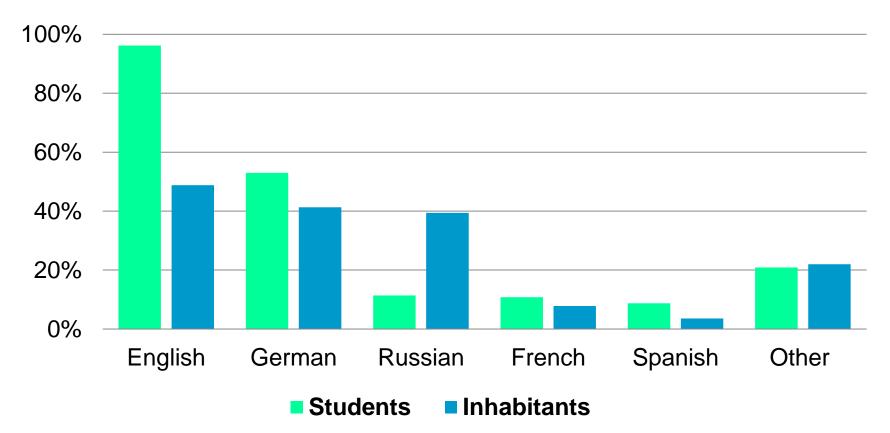
There are **3 670 foreign university students** in Wroclaw (4th place in Poland):

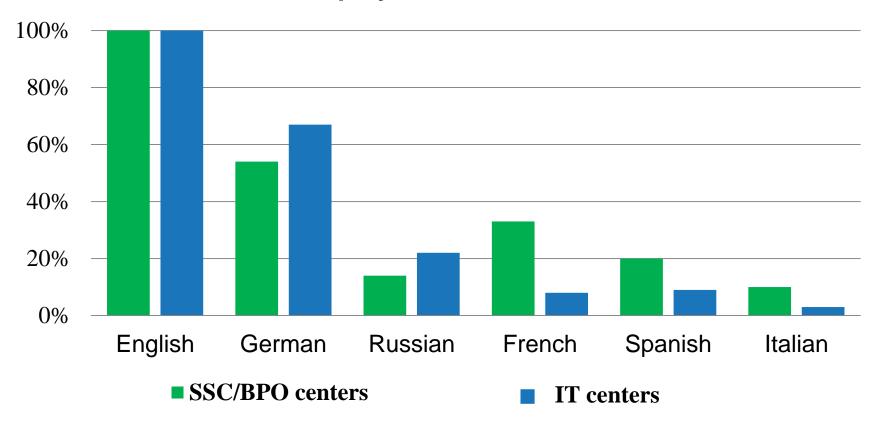


Command of foreign languages among students and inhabitants in Wroclaw



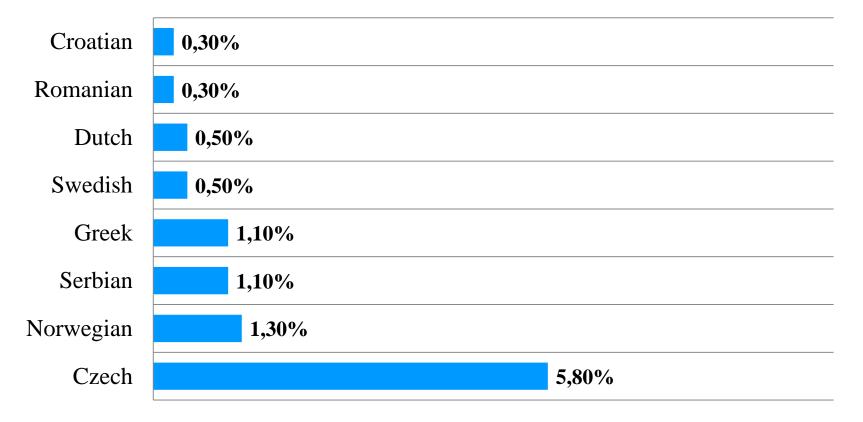


Command of foreign languages – SSC/BPO & IT employees in Wroclaw





Command of less popular European languages – SSC/BPO & IT



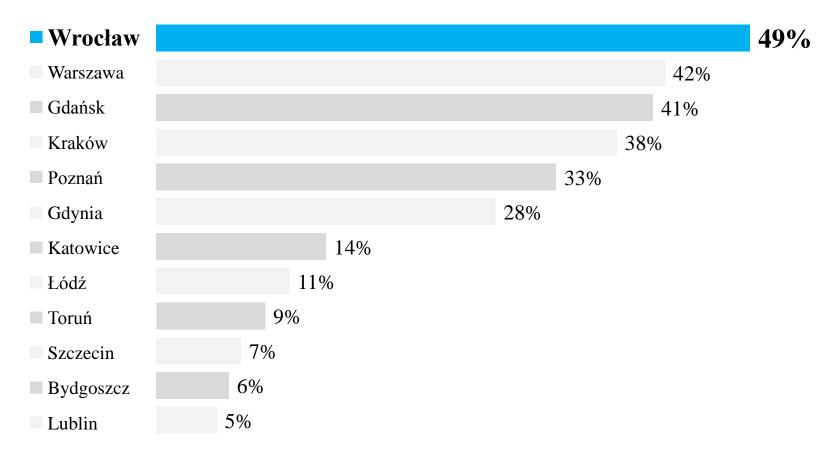
